














SMART GROWTH Methodist Physicians Clinic

 patients.






MPC Locations

SMART GROWTH MWH NICU Expansion Highlights



Expanded wing: Methodist Women's Hospital was built with expansion in mind. Footings in the roof surfaces allows for outward and upward growth. The NICU expansion extends off the existing third floor space which faces southeast toward Dodge.



Family lounge: Having a NICU baby can be stressful. A new lounge provides family members a place to take a break, eat a meal or interact with other NICU parents, while remaining close to their child.



Single room: The new 14,000 square foot space features 13 single/private rooms.

Research clearly shows that the smallest NICU babies do the best when they are in private rooms.



Head walls: Babies in the NICU can require lots of equipment. Functional head walls are designed to provide easy access to the multiple systems necessary for supporting NICU patients.



Room for multiples: The NICU expansion includes 18 rooms, five of which will accommodate multiples. The large room space allows staff to easily care for multiple babies at one time.



Nursing/rounding station: The general nursing station area features computers and a large wall-mounted monitor for use during daily rounds. Important information about patients can be displayed on the monitor for enhanced collaboration.



QUALITY & SAFETY How can you keep our patients safe?



Handwashing, Handwashing, Handwashing

Chlorohexidine (CHG) Bathing for patients

- For clinical staff to evaluate the need for additional lines like urinary catheters and peripherally inserted intravenous catheters (PICCs)
- Environmental Cleanliness is everyone's responsibility
 - High touch surfaces
 - Patient care equipment
 - Patient Rooms





QUALITY & SAFETY

Positive Observations from Infection Control Assessment Program

- Complimented surgical and sterile processing staff on their knowledge of their departments and role in reducing infections.
- Complimented the actions taken to reduce patient risk during procedures that require the heater cooler device. Stated Best Practice they have seen in Nebraska.
- Repeatedly remarked on the overall cleanliness of Women's Hospital – on every unit they surveyed.



QUALITY & SAFETY Areas for Improvement

- Contact times of cleaning products need to be reviewed. This
 was a consistent finding at Methodist and Women's Hospitals.
- ICAP staff recommended further education and training for staff on cleaning of probes and the use of the Trophon HLD system at Methodist and Women's Hospitals.
- Storage of Supplies:
 - MH: Supplies should not be stored on the dock, but should be moved to a clean storage area.
 - WH: Remove wooden pallets and corrugated boxes from central supply area. The task of removing supplies from boxes could be done at another location.
