

TORNADO WATCH

Conditions are favorable for a tornado to develop.

Steps to Take:

Clinical Areas

- » Close window coverings, such as drapes.
- » Locate supplies and equipment that would be needed if the watch is upgraded to a warning:
 - \circ i.e. next IV solution bag, oxygen extension tubing, extra electrical extension cord
 - Test flashlight functionality; extra batteries

Non-Clinical Areas

- » Prepare your work area with equipment or emergency supplies (i.e. flashlights).
- » Close window drapes.
- » Clear hallways and designated areas to prepare for movement.

TORNADO WARNING

Tornado has been sighted, sirens are sounding and the Weather Service is advising everyone to take shelter.

Steps to Take:

Clinical Areas

- » Move patients to a safer location.
- » Close patient room doors.
- » Transfer needed supplies with patient.

Non-Clinical Areas

- » Move employees and necessary supplies to designated areas.
- » Stay away from outside walls and windows.
- » Remain in designated area until Warning is canceled by Manager.
